- Part time nursing faculty will not be counted for calculating total number of faculty required for a College.
- 3. Irrespective of number of admissions, all faculty positions (Lecturer to Professor)must be filled.
- For M.Sc.(N) programme appropriate number of M.Sc. faculty in each specialist be appointed subject to the condition that total number of teaching faculty ceiling is maintained.
- All nursing teachers must possess a basic University or equivalent qualification. They shall be registered under the Maharashtra State Nursing Registration Act, 1966.
- Nursing faculty in Nursing College except tutor / clinical instructors must possess the requisite recognized post graduate qualification in nursing subjects.
- 7. All teachers of nursing other than Principal and Vice-Principal should spend at least 4 hours in the clinical area for enrical teaching and / or supervision of care every day.
